Keeping you, your family & the community safe:

Whilst we appreciate you all know how to stay safe while volunteering, the relaxation of lockdown rules can change others behaviour.

As such, it is worth the reminder that the safety conditions that have always been in place for HH volunteers remain.

Specifically:

1. Stay outdoors when interacting with the person requiring help.
2. No lifts in cars
3. Keep at least 2 meters apart
4. Clean hands before and after any interaction
5. Do Not place hands on face
6. Cough or sneeze into elbow
7. Consider hand hygiene if exchanging cash.
