An update on Covid-19 in Suffolk

Blueprint for the districts future development to progress

BDC have welcomed a decision by the Planning Inspectorate to allow work on the Joint Local Plan to continue - meaning that the right developments happen in the right places at the right time.

Work began on Carbon Cutting Solar Carport Scheme

Work has begun on installing solar carports which will help power and slash carbon emissions at our two main leisure centres in Sudbury and Hadleigh as part of our council's plans to tackle climate change.

Babergh urges National Highways to unblock Copdock

Babergh and Mid Suffolk District Councils have submitted a joint response to a consultation by National Highways on proposed improvements to the Copdock Interchange urging the creation of a new link road to keep business traffic flowing to the East and West of the A14.

"You must Pay" – Warning to developers

Babergh District Council was awarded an out of court settlement of £163,590 in unpaid Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) from developers Marden Essex Ltd.

Developers are required to pay CIL when building new houses in Babergh ensuring that local facilities keep pace with housing growth and supporting the council's ongoing ambition for its communities to be attractive, successful and connected places for people to live and work in. Babergh CIL framework provides a proportion of CIL awards of 15% to local parish councils and 25% if they have an adopted Neighbourhood Plan if the development is within their parish. However CIL monies can be paid outside of that rule if a parish proposes a well-planned project with costings that meet the criteria.



Fund to help Businesses

Before Christmas the Chancellor of the Exchequer set out a £1bn fund to help businesses hit by the Covid crisis.

BDC is awaiting further details of the fund but it is understood that it includes cash grants of up to £6000 per premises for businesses that are eligible. We will be updating everyone as soon as more detailed information is available from the Government.
