

Babergh District Council Elections – 4 May 2023

The history of the political composition of Babergh District Council has always been strewn with change and unpredictability. The results of this year's local elections has been no different.

The Council is made up of 32 seats so for a party or group to have a majority to lead the council requires them to achieve 16 seats plus 1. No one party or group has achieved that this time.

Green Party 10 Independents 9 Conservatives – 7 Liberal Dems 5 Labour 1 Total 32

For Party and Group Leaders the discussions are already in progress to negotiate and agree the best way forward to cover Cabinet portfolios and Chairmanships of Major Committees – Planning, Overview & Scrutiny, Audit and Standards, Licensing and Regulatory, Shared Revenue Partnership, Chair and Vice Chair of the Council and Leader and Deputy Leader of the Council. All of which do require knowledge, experience and skill. Recognising that all the above are live streamed and are publicly recorded meetings.

All the decisions taken about proposed nominations will be presented to the Annual Council Meeting on 23 May 2023 and duly voted upon.
