Clerk's report to meeting held on 18th September 2023

- 1. A date has now been fixed for the litter pick we will send details and hopefully some photos as requested by Public Realm.
- 2. I have completed a grant application from Little Magic Grants towards the accessible gate at The Reade Road end of the Reade Field and should hear within a month if they are considering it.
- 3. I have also asked for a grant from Cllr Mary McLaren towards the defibrillator
- 4. The missing sign "The Street" hasn't yet been replaced, but has been promised.
- 5. The hedge which was causing sight issues on the left-hand side of Harkstead Road between New Lane and Wall Farm has been trimmed and the sightline is better.
- 6. The latch is still missing on the gate to the children's playpark O. Abbott has agreed to replace and the clerk has sent a reminder,
- 7. Playquip have identified a post badly rusting on the Field Gate and have offered to repair at a cost of £180. whilst they are installing the accessible gate.
- 8. The defibrillator has now been ordered. The concrete post will need to be put in and left for a period of 2 weeks before the defib can be attached to it.
- 9. A site meeting took place re the pavilion with a surveyor who had been allocated to us via Suffolk Pro Help.
- 10. The application for funding for the replacement of the play equipment required the council to have an Environmental policy. A draft policy is attached to the supporting papers.
- 11. The Asset Register is normally reviewed at the March and September meetings. It was reviewed in March, but I am proposing the next review is postponed until October, so that the Defibrillator and any new play equipment can be included.
