## **Babergh District Council Meeting**

Due to the purdah rules during the past election period BDC did not meet in April but will reconvene on Monday 20<sup>th</sup> May for the Annual Council Meeting where appointments to Committees and responsibilities will be proposed and agreed. As BDC has a Rainbow Cabinet, Councillor Deborah Saw (Green Party) will be elected as Leader of the Council for one year. Councillor John Ward (Ind) will step down from his Acting Leader Role which was on behalf of Councillor Dave Busby (LD) who remains very unwell.

# **Police and Crime Commissioner**

Many congratulations to Tim Passmore who was elected as the Suffolk Police and Crime Commissioner on Thursday 2 May 2024.with 52,968 votes. We wish him well in his new term of office. He is one of only two police and crime commissioners to hold the role for the county since the positions were created in 2012.

# Short-term Parking Charges to be further discussed.

Babergh District Council's cabinet will further discuss the decision to introduce modest short-term parking charges in Sudbury, Hadleigh and Lavenham. The Babergh Overview and Scrutiny Committee had already reviewed the process of the public engagement prior to the Cabinet making their initial decision. The O&S Committee made recommendations to be reviewed in the light of their scrutiny of the consultation process. The Acting Leader of the Council responded to the Committee. The Cabinet made their decision to proceed with the Parking Charges. A "Call In" process was then invoked by a Ward Member from Hadleigh. A "Call In" can be invoked by any District Councillor regarding a Cabinet Decision within 5 days from the Cabinet Decision being made. However, as we have a Cabinet Model of Decision Making the decision made cannot be overturned but the information and evidence by which the Decision was reached can be scrutinised by the Babergh Overview and Scrutiny Committee Meeting (4 hours) scrutinising Planning Enforcement and the Call In which lasted 3 hours. Recommendations were made to Cabinet for consideration but only one Call In can be made per each decision. As I was Chairing both meetings it was a very long day.

### Government Grants for E.V Charging points.

The Office for Zero Emission Vehicles has several grants available up to 31 March 2025 to help install EV charge points.

These are for:

- Renters and flat owners (up to £350)
- Households with on-street parking (up to £350)
- Landlords (up to £30,000)
- Businesses and workplaces (up to £350 or £30,000 depending on the scheme)
- State funded education institutions (up to £100,000)
