Email re speed limit on road from Holbrook to Harkstead

Hello,

I had a query I was hoping you could help me with.

I live at Brick Cottages on Harkstead Road. The speed limit is the National Speed Limit from Fishponds Lane in Holbrook until Lower Harkstead.

I see that this is the South Suffolk Route B3 and there is also a campaign to promote safer cycling on the Shotley peninsula (links below).

I say this as I also walk along this road, and I note the number of walkers and cyclists and runners I see. I also note that the National Speed Limit is 60 mph, and I've had a number of uncomfortable near misses when out walking to or from my front door, or out running. The road is narrow, twists and turns and in all fairness to drivers it isn't easy to see who may be around the corner. It's also tricky for walkers to decide which side of the road is safer for them.

I was wondering if any consideration had been given to extending the 30 mph limit between Holbrook and Lower Holbrook, to make the road safer for walkers and cyclists and runners?
