3. Responsibilities


Holbrook Parish Council is responsible for three areas of land within the parish boundary.

- 3.1 The Reade Field, between Reade Road and The Street, is leased from the Greenwich Hospital Estates (The Royal Hospital School) for an annual peppercorn rent of one Suffolk reed. The lease began on 15th July 1968 and runs for 99 years. The reed is usually presented to the Headmaster of the RHS at the Annual Parish Meeting. The land management company is Strutt and Parker, who are consulted on issues arising and significant changes, new equipment and so on. There are covenants within the lease for the maintenance of the Reade Field and its facilities.
- 3.2 Church Green, a small area of grass in front of All Saints Church on Church Hill, is registered common land. This is maintained by the Parish Council who look after the village sign, war memorial, bench, dog and litter bins and grass cutting.
- 3.3 Alton Green, an area of uncultivated land in Lower Holbrook, is registered common land and contains a pond which is maintained by the Parish Council, and 2 benches which are insured by the Council but one is maintained by the family who installed it in memory of their relations.

Both Alton Green and Church Green are subject to the protection of the Local Authority (Holbrook Parish Council) under section 9 of the Commons Registration Act 1965. Section 9 states that "...any local authority in whose area the land or part of the land is situated may take such steps for the protection of the land against unlawful interference as could be taken by an owner in possession of the land, and may (without prejudice to any power exercisable apart from this section) institute proceedings for any offence committed in respect of the land."



Appendix 1: Map of Holbrook


