Council Leaders back “Suffolk to the power of three” option as part of the LGR consultation.

The Government statutory consultation closes on the 11 January 2026. Babergh District Council Community Governance Review

Babergh District Council commenced a Community Governance Review of its parishes, towns and un-parished areas across the District in October 2025. In May Town and Parish Councils had been contacted to consider any changes in their community governance arrangements with initial requests to be submitted between 23 October and 7 November 2025.

The CGR working group met in November to discuss the requests. Consultations began on Monday 8 December and will continue until Friday 23 January 2026.

Residents, businesses, political representatives and other stakeholders of these areas under review are invited to send their comments by 23 January.
