

TEXT OF EMAIL FROM RESIDENTS AT ALTON GREEN

Dear Sirs,

We would draw the Parish Council's attention to the Pond at Alton Green.

The Pond is choked with weeds, rushes and brambles and is silted up. It is in a worse condition than it has ever been in the past.

The Pond acts as a reservoir for run-off from the surrounding fields and roads. If it is not maintained and managed it will dry up. Moor hens and ducks strive to live on the Pond and there is now almost no space for them.

When we get the torrential deluge, as we will, there is danger of flooding, as has happened in the past.

We would like to meet someone from the Parish Council on site to discuss our concerns over the Pond.
